

SEE 2010 Terms & Conditions

General Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions are to be followed:

1. The decision of the evaluators will be final.
2. All the participants need to confirm their arrival two days before the competition.
3. The participants are to report management SEE'10 by 9:00am sharp on the day of competition.
4. The participants failing to report management SEE'10 by 9:00am will be barred from competition.
5. It is obligatory for every participant to wear his/her university identity card along with SEE' 10 tags and to show when demanded.
6. Participants must observe formal attire.
7. Discipline should be maintained at all times. Failure to do so would result in immediate disqualification and removal from the exhibition premises.
8. To ensure security, the participants once entered will not be allowed to leave the premises for any reason.
9. SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.
10. Participants are to collect their SEE'10 tags a day before the event from PAF-KIET City Campus. They will be allowed to enter the competition premises after showing their tags.
11. Registration fee for final year project competition and research paper competition is PKR500 per team.
12. Registration fee for circuit designing competition and speed wiring competition is PKR250 per team.
13. Registration fee will be collected at the day of competition.

Terms and Conditions for Final Year Project Competition

1. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
2. Information given by the students must be correct. In case of any wrong information, the participation of the team can be challenged.
3. An institute can send more than one projects, such that each project group consists of only four members.
4. The students participating in this competition must attach a verification letter, verifying that the project to be exhibited is a final year project and is made during their four years BE program. The project can be verified by any faculty member of that university and contact details of the faculty member must be provided.
5. The final year project should be combination of hardware and software.
6. The participants of SEE' 10 are to bring their projects to PAF-KIET two days before the day of competition.
7. PAF-KIET is not bound to fulfill any hardware/software or stationary requirement other than power cords and extensions.
8. Equipment will only be provided for testing projects at PAF-KIET before the day of competition.
9. All the final year project participants should bring technical details of their project.
10. Projects must be original, practical, complete and fully functional. Incomplete/malfunctioning projects will be disqualified.
11. The final year project participants must also bring a poster, aiding the project. Poster should be 3 ft vertical and 2 ft horizontal.
12. The decision of the evaluators will be final.
13. Registration fee for final year project competition is PKR500 per team.
14. SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.

Terms and Conditions for Research Paper Competition

1. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
2. Information given by the students must be correct. In case of any wrong information, the participation of the representative can be challenged.
3. An institute can send multiple numbers of research papers, each represented by maximum of four students.
4. The participants are to provide an abstract of their research paper along with the registration form. The abstract should be of maximum 250 words.
5. Registration forms received without abstract will not be entertained.
6. The students participating in research paper competition are to present the research paper with an oral presentation.
7. Presence of participant(s) on the day of event is necessary.
8. The research paper participants must also bring a poster. Poster should be 3 ft vertical and 2 ft horizontal.
9. The final award selection will be made by evaluators based on the manuscript, the poster and the oral presentation.
10. The decision of the evaluators will be final.
11. Registration fee for research paper competition is PKR500 per team.
12. SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.

Terms and Conditions for Circuit Designing Competition

1. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
2. Information given by the students must be correct. In case of any wrong information, the participation of the team can be challenged.
3. An institute can send maximum two teams for circuit designing competition, such that each team has only two members.
4. Each team will work independently on its project. No access to the Internet is permitted. Each team receives a sack of parts. No other parts are allowed.
5. Questions will be asked about the circuits and the concepts of circuit analysis, digital electronics etc.
6. Meeting the specifications (the closeness of the teams' results to the initial specifications requirements) as demonstrated to the judges, the economy and "cleanness" of the design are the judgment criteria.
7. The decision of the evaluators will be final.
8. Registration fee for circuit designing competition is PKR250 per team.
9. SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.
10. **Mandatory requirements for participation in Circuit Designing competition:**
 - a. An Institute must be participating in either final year project competition or research paper competition.
 - b. Teams participating in final year project competition and research paper competition cannot participate in circuit designing competition.

Terms and Conditions for Speed Wiring Competition

1. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
2. Information given by the students must be correct. In case of any wrong information, the participation of the team can be challenged.
3. An institute can send maximum two teams for speed wiring competition, such that each team has only two members.
4. The circuit is to be implemented on bread board.
5. Questions will be asked about the circuits and the concepts of circuit analysis, electronic devices etc.
6. Team achieving maximum approximation to the problems solution within less time and less penalties would be the winner.
7. The decision of the evaluators will be final.
8. Registration fee for speed wiring competition is PKR250 per team.
9. SEE organizing committee reserves the right to change any rules and regulations without any prior notice.
10. **Mandatory requirements for participation in Speed Wiring competition:**
 - a. An institute must be participating in either final year project competition or research paper competition.
 - b. Teams participating in final year project competition and research paper competition cannot participate in speed wiring competition.
